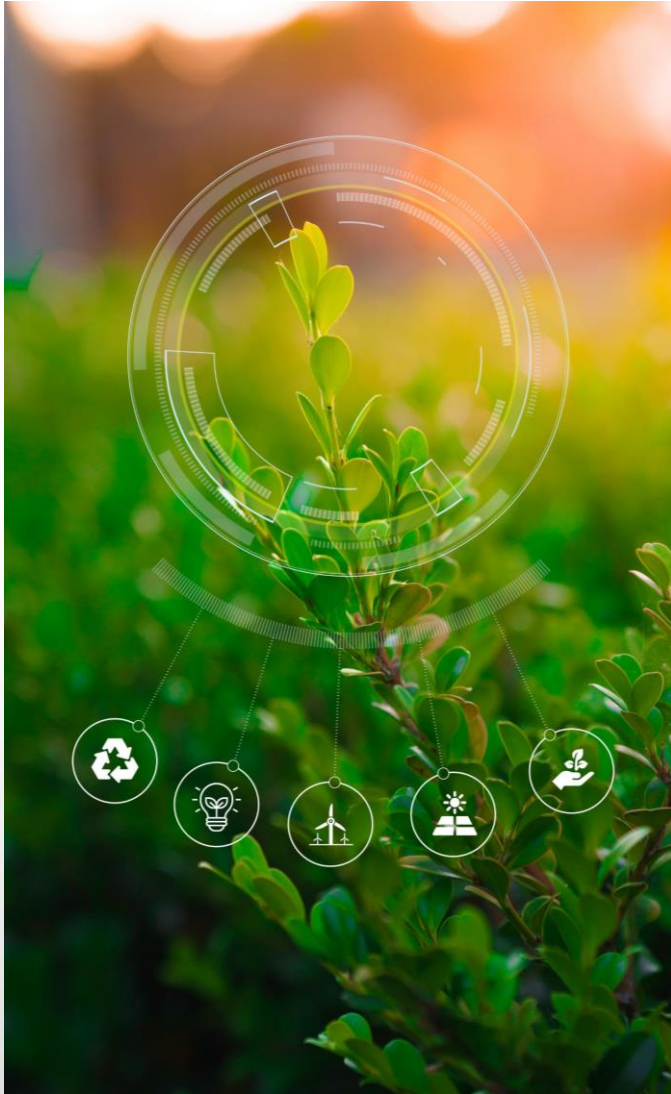

Alignment with Ethical Principles

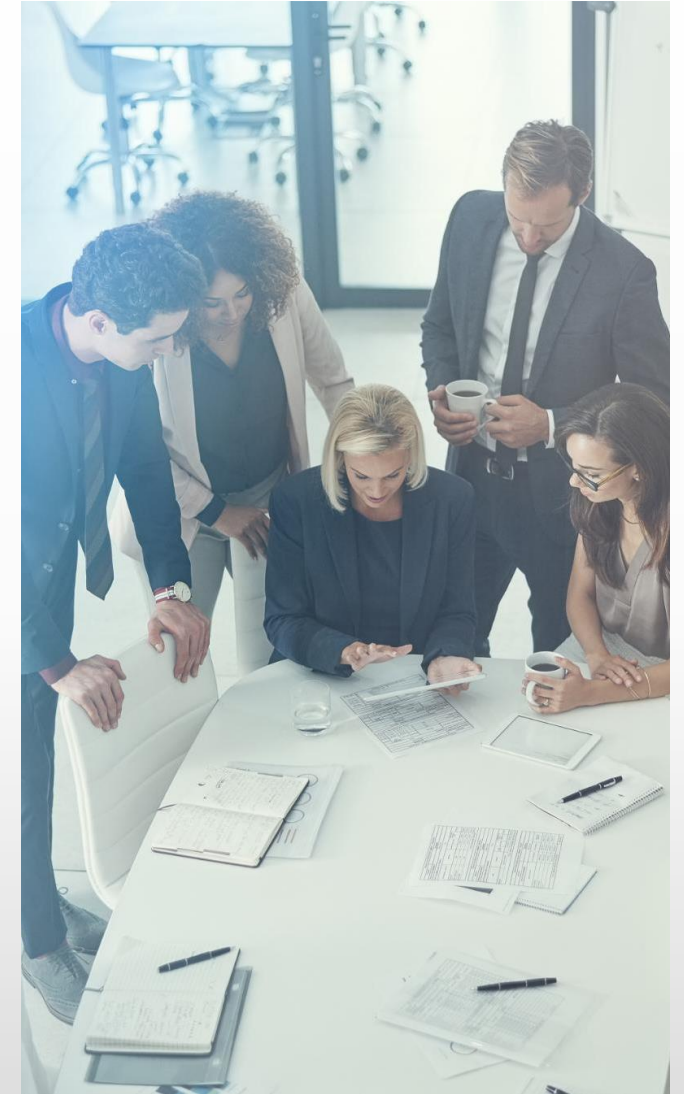
Quality objectives need to align with ethical values and be clearly communicated across the organization.
